### **Extension and refurbishment to Beaumont Primary School in Purley**

London Borough of Croydon has given the go ahead to Wates Construction Ltd to commence work on site on the Beaumont Primary School. The Works will comprise a 3 class room extension with a new ICT area and offices, together with some refurbishment of the existing school. The extension will be single storey complementing the existing building.

Preliminary work has already started on site, and a temporary car park has been provided for staff and visitors. The site has been secured during the recent half term break to ensure that no unauthorised access can be gained to the site from either Beaumont or the adjacent St. Nicholas School. The foundations for the new extension are scheduled to commence in March with completion due in the autumn of this year. Wates will work very closely with the School to carry out the construction work in the most efficient manner.

The design of the extension has maximised the off site manufacture of components. This will reduce the quantity of deliveries of building materials and thus reduce the traffic congestion of the local roads. Wates will arrange to receive deliveries out side of the main school drop off and collection times. In addition we will ensure that any disruption, to the local roads and importantly to residents is kept to the absolute minimum.

We intend to keep the local residents informed of progress, key activities and deliveries by issue of a monthly news letter.
